

AIRSPACE SECURITY CHECKLIST



1

Gather any staff or organizations who may be affected by your security plan to discuss expectations

This could include Security Team, IT Team, Operations Team, etc. Think of keeping your Accounting Department in the loop as well as they may need to approve expenses



2

After discussing with your team, make a clear list of your security needs

This will be useful once you begin contacting airspace security providers



3

Begin evaluating the offers for airspace security providers in your area

The Internet is an excellent place to start, but after narrowing down the candidates to two or three – contact their Sales representatives directly to get more details



4

Take your time

Once you've chosen an airspace security provider, set aside time for them to study your site layout and propose solutions



5

Lay the foundation

After signing your contract, prepare your site, removing any obstacles to installation and updating equipment or services if necessary



6

Learn the ropes

Set aside time to train on the new system and don't forget to invite any personnel who may need to access the system in the future
